By Mr. Keenan of Boston, petition of Matthew L. McGrath, Jr., and others for revising the permanent salary schedule for state officers and employees and for changing annual salary increments thereunder. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT REVISING THE PERMANENT SALARY SCHEDULE OF CERTAIN STATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES AND BY CHANGING THE ANNUAL SALARY INCREMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR THE ATTAINMENT OF THE MAXIMUM SALARY AFTER SIX YEARS OF SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 785
3 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out the increments and the yearly rates of
5 salary payable until the maximum salary is reached,
6 and substituting therefor figures providing that each
7 year the minimum salary shall be increased by one
8 sixth of the difference between the minimum and
9 maximum salary for each grade; and that the maxi-
10 mum salary for each grade be payable in the seventh
11 year of service in such grade.
