## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

---

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED BRANCH OF THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH QUARTERS AND NECESSARY LIVING FACILITIES, AND SHALL BE RATIONED AT THE EXPENSE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 22 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 487 of the acts of 1949, is hereby  
3 further amended by adding the following new sec-  
4 tion:—

5 *Section 7B.* Members of the uniformed branch of  
6 the division of state police shall be provided with  
7 quarters and necessary living facilities and shall be  
8 rationed at the expense of the commonwealth.
