AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF ASSISTANT SUPERVISOR OF VETERANS' SERVICES UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The person holding the office of assistant super-
2 visor of veterans' services in the office of the com-
3 missioner of veterans' services shall, upon the effec-
4 tive date of this act, become subject to the civil
5 service laws and rules, and his tenure of office shall be
6 unlimited, subject, however, to said laws, but he
7 shall be subjected by the division of civil service to a
8 qualifying examination, and if he passes said exam-
9 ination he shall be certified for said office and shall be
10 deemed to be permanently appointed thereto without
11 being required to serve any probationary period.
