AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF INDEX COMMISSIONERS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY TO THE REGISTER OF DEEDS IN SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 31 of chapter 36 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the same and substi-  
3 tuting therefor the following:—  
4 *Section 31.* The work hitherto done under the  
5 supervision of the index commissioners, as provided  
6 in said section thirty-one, shall be done under the  
7 supervision of the register of deeds in Suffolk county,  
8 who shall retain all present employees hitherto em-  
9 ployed by the index commissioners, so far as the said  
10 register deems it necessary for the proper performance  
11 of the functions hereby transferred to it.
