RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION OF THE NEW ENGLAND MILK PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the committee on agriculture is
2 hereby authorized to make an investigation and study
3 of the organization, conduct, policies and finances of
4 the New England Milk Producers Association, organ-
5 ized under the laws of Massachusetts, and to make
6 recommendations concerning these and all related
7 matters. Said committee shall hold hearings, shall be
8 provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere,
9 and shall have power to summon witnesses, require
10 the production of books, records, contracts and papers,
11 and require the giving of testimony under oath. Said
12 committee may expend for expenses and legal, clerical
13 and other assistance such sums, not exceeding, in the
14 aggregate, one thousand dollars, as may hereafter be
15 appropriated. Said committee shall report to the
16 general court the results of its investigation and its
17 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legis-
18 lation necessary to carry said recommendations into
19 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
20 representatives not later than the first Wednesday of
21 November in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-two.
