

HOUSE No. 1720

By Mr. Marston of Haverhill, petition of Charles S. Marston, 3rd, that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be authorized to provide special registration plates for licensees of motor vehicles who have not been involved in accidents for five years. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE SPECIAL NUMBER PLATES FOR LICENSEES WHO HAVE NOT BEEN INVOLVED IN ACCIDENTS FOR FIVE YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 6A, inserted by section 3 of
3 chapter 432 of the acts of 1948, the following new
4 section:—

5 *Section 6B.* The registrar of motor vehicles shall
6 issue to every licensee a special number plate having
7 the initials of such licensee, providing, that such
8 licensee has not been involved in any accident for the
9 last five years next preceding the issuance of such
10 number plate. The registrar shall issue such number
11 plates upon the payment of a fee of five dollars, which
12 shall be in addition to the fee provided in section
13 thirty-three.
