AN ACT RELATING TO UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF WORKERS ON UN- ORTHODOX WORK SHIFTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 23 of chapter 151A, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 763 of the acts of 1951, is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end the following
4 subsection:—

5 (g) With respect to an individual whose work week
6 normally includes Sunday, work performed on Sunday
7 shall, for the purpose of computing the waiting period,
8 be regarded as performed in the work week next pre-
9 ceding said Sunday.
