AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF DOUBLE COMPENSATION BY CERTAIN INSURERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of chapter 152 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the fol-
3 lowing: — Any insurer refusing to pay an employee
4 compensation shall, upon the determination by the
5 reviewing board, any member of the department or
6 any court that compensation should be paid the said
7 employee, pay double the amount of compensation
8 which the employee would ordinarily receive under
9 the terms of this act for a period not to exceed six
10 months.
