AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT TO RESIDENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE ASSIGNMENT OF STALLS AT RACE TRACKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state racing commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed, acting under the powers conferred
3 upon it by section nine of chapter one hundred
4 and twenty-eight A of the General Laws, to require
5 that eighty per cent of the stalls assigned in conjunc-
6 tion with conducting the pari-mutuel system at horse
7 racing meetings shall be assigned to residents of the
8 commonwealth.
