RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF THE ADVISABILITY OF BUILDING PLAYGROUNDS, AND SWIMMING AND WADING POOLS IN THE SOUTH END AREA OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commission
2 investigate and study the advisability of building play-
3 grounds and swimming and wading pools in the south
4 end of Boston. Said commission shall report to the
5 general court the results of its investigations and study
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts
7 of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations
8 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
9 house of representatives on or before the first Wednes-
10 day in December of the current year.
