In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ORLEANS TO ACQUIRE FOR PARK PURPOSES A CERTAIN CEMETERY LOCATED IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Orleans, acting by its
2 board of park commissioners, is hereby authorized
3 to take by eminent domain, under chapter seventy-
4 nine of the General Laws, or acquire by gift, pur-
5 chase or otherwise, for the purpose of a memorial
6 park, the old Methodist Cemetery, sometimes so
7 called, located at the corner of Main street and Grand
8 Army of the Republic highway (Massachusetts high-
9 way Route 6) in said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
