*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.*

I am enclosing herewith proposed legislation under the provisions of chapter 7, section 7, of the General Laws:— An Act Further Compensating the Assistant Commissioner of Mental Health for Certain Duties performed by Him.

This is an amendment to an item of the appropriation act, chapter 490 of the Acts of 1951, as amended by chapter 806 of the Acts of 1951, to permit, under the regulations of the Comptroller, the payment of the sum mentioned to the Assistant Commissioner of Mental Health.

The wording of the appropriation act at the present time does not permit approval of such payment, and is undoubtedly a result of the hurried consideration of the particular item at the time of prorogation.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT FURTHER COMPENSATING THE ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH FOR CERTAIN DUTIES PERFORMED BY HIM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Item 1701-02 is hereby further amended by adding  
2 after the word "rules", in line eight, the following:—  
3 And including for the assistant commissioner of  
4 mental health, while performing the powers and duties  
5 as commissioner of mental health for the period  
6 April first, nineteen hundred and fifty, through  
7 November thirteenth, nineteen hundred and fifty-  
8 one, the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars.
