RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MEDICAL SCHOOL BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established
2 by chapter seventy of the resolves of nineteen hundred
3 and fifty-one for the purpose of making an investiga-
4 tion and study relative to the establishment of a
5 medical school by the University of Massachusetts,
6 in the course of its investigation and study, shall
7 consider the subject matter of current house docu-
8 ment numbered 147, relative to providing for the
9 construction and maintenance of schools of dentistry,
10 medicine and public health on the campus of the
11 University of Massachusetts in the town of Amherst,
12 of current house document numbered 292, relative to
13 establishing various schools in the University of

16 medical school by the University of Massachusetts in
17 metropolitan Boston, of current house document num-
