AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF MALDEN SHALL BE FIXED BY ORDINANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 chapter ninety-three of the acts of nineteen hundred
3 and eight or of any other law, the compensation of
4 members of the fire department of the city of Malden
5 shall be fixed by ordinance.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city,
3 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not other-
4 wise.
