## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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*Ordered*, That the committee on Insurance be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court to study the subject matter of current Senate Document numbered 166, and of current House Document numbered 907. Said committee may travel within and without the Commonwealth and may expend for clerical and other assistance such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
