## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAKING EFFECT IN THE TOWN OF SCITUATE OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW AUTHORIZING INCREASES OF PENSIONS AND OTHER BENEFITS PAYABLE TO CERTAIN FORMER PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The provisions of chapter eight hundred and twenty  
2 of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty, having been  
3 accepted by the voters of the town of Scituate at a  
4 special town meeting held on October fifteenth, nine-  
5 teen hundred and fifty-one, shall be effective in said  
6 town as of January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-  
7 one.
