## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF QUARTERS  
IN THE STATE HOUSE FOR THE USE OF THE JEWISH WAR  
VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES, DEPARTMENT OF  
MASSACHUSETTS, INC.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 8 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking out section 17, as most recently amended  
3 by chapter 807 of the acts of 1951, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following section:—  
5 *Section 17.* There shall be set apart and suitably  
6 furnished a room or rooms in the state house for the  
7 use of the Massachusetts department of The American  
8 Legion, of the United Spanish War Veterans, of the  
9 Disabled American Veterans of the World War, of  
10 the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, of  
11 the American Veterans of World War II, AMVETS,  
12 of the Veterans of Indian Wars, of Italian American  
13 World War Veterans of the United States, Inc.,

14 Department of Massachusetts, and of the Jewish  
15 War Veterans of the United States, Department of  
16 Massachusetts, Inc., respectively, such room or rooms  
17 to be under the charge of the state commanders of the  
18 respective departments, subject to this chapter. The  
19 headquarters thus established for each of the afore-  
20 said departments shall be used for storing and pre-  
21 serving the records and other property of the depart-  
22 ment and relics and mementos of the World wars and  
23 the Spanish war.
