AN ACT TO PERMIT THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY OF CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER THIRTY-TWO OF THE GENERAL LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section sixty
2 of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as most
3 recently amended by chapter six hundred and seventy-
4 eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five,
5 sections fifty-six to fifty-nine, inclusive, of said chap-
6 ter thirty-two shall take effect in the town of Shrews-
7 bury upon their acceptance prior to June first, nine-
8 teen hundred and fifty-two, by the retiring authority
9 of said town, as defined by section fifty-nine of said
10 chapter thirty-two, as appearing in the Tercentenary
11 Edition.
