### RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO SMALL LOANS.

---

1    *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission to  
2 consist of two members of the senate to be designated  
3 by the president thereof, four members of the house  
4 of representatives to be designated by the speaker  
5 thereof, and three members to be appointed by the  
6 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of  
7 making an investigation and study of current house  
8 document numbered 2321 and related matters, amend-  
9 ing the Small Loans Act. Said commission may  
10 expend for necessary assistance and expenses such  
11 sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor. The  
12 commission shall report to the general court the  
13 results of its investigation and study, and its recom-  
14 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-  
15 tion necessary to carry such recommendations into  
16 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house  
17 of representatives on or before the first Wednesday  
18 of December in the current year.
