

HOUSE No. 2432

By Messrs. Kahalas of Boston and Nathanson of Boston, petition of Abraham H. Kahalas and Louis K. Nathanson that the city of Boston be authorized to sell certain park land on Stratton Street in said city. Cities.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO SELL CERTAIN PARK LAND SITUATE ON STRATTON STREET IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provi-
2 sion of general or special law, the city of Boston, by
3 its mayor, may sell to the Boston Housing Authority
4 any part or parts of the whole of the land in said city
5 bounded northerly by land of the city of Boston;
6 easterly by land of Boston Catholic Cemetery Asso-
7 ciation and land now or formerly of William E. Steele
8 et al.; westerly in part by the easterly end of Stratton
9 street; and southerly and westerly by land of various
10 owners and by the northerly and easterly lines of
11 Stratton street, containing 1,210,492 square feet, more
12 or less, and as shown on a plan entitled "City of
13 Boston, Franklin Field, Stratton Street, Dorchester,
14 November 26, 1951, James W. Haley, Chief Engineer,

15 Street Laying-Out Department.”, and held by said
16 city for public park purposes; provided, that the
17 board of park commissioners of said city has assented
18 or shall, by vote at a regular or special meeting of
19 said board, assent to the sale; and, provided further,
20 that the city council of said city, by a vote of a ma-
21 jority of all of its members, approved by the mayor,
22 has authorized or shall authorize the said sale.

1 SECTION 2. The mayor of said city, in the name
2 and on behalf of said city, shall execute and deliver
3 any instrument necessary to convey any land sold
4 under authority of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
