## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Two.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY  
BY THE ART COMMISSION FOR THE COMMONWEALTH  
RELATIVE TO PLAQUES FOR VETERANS.

1     *Resolved*, That the art commission for the common-  
2 wealth shall make an investigation and study relative  
3 to current house document numbered 536, providing  
4 for the placing of a plaque in the state house in recog-  
5 nition of medal of honor winners in World War II;  
6 and current house document numbered 1816, authoriz-  
7 ing the metropolitan district commission to create a  
8 memorial to Civil War veterans in the city of Boston.  
9 Said commission shall report, as soon as may be, to the  
10 general court the results of its investigation and study,  
11 including complete plans, specifications, a proper loca-  
12 tion and costs, together with drafts of legislation  
13 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,  
14 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of repre-  
15 sentatives from time to time but not later than the  
16 first Wednesday in December of the current year.
