By Mr. Murphy of Peabody, petition of John T. Berry and others that the manager of the municipal lighting commission for the city of Peabody be exempted from civil service laws and rules. Civil Service.

AN ACT EXEMPTING THE MANAGER OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF PEABODY FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286 of the acts of 1951 is
2 hereby amended by striking out section 2 and in-
3 serting in place thereof the following:—

4 *Section 2.* The commission shall establish the
5 office of manager, and shall fix the salary of such
6 office. Said manager shall not be a member of the
7 commission and shall not be subject to the provisions
8 of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws and the
9 rules made thereunder.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
