AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAKING OF LOBSTERS AND
EDIBLE CRABS FROM THE COASTAL WATERS OF NAHANT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 37 of chapter 130 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 paragraph most recently amended by section 1 of
4 chapter 76 of the acts of 1948 and inserting in place
5 thereof the following: —

6 In the waters of Dukes county, and of Marblehead,
7 Nahant and Swampscott in Essex county, and of
8 Revere in Suffolk county, no such pot, trap or other
9 contrivance shall be buoyed otherwise than separately
10 and plainly.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
