AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO CONVEY TO THE DIVISION OF WATERWAYS OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS ALL THE RIGHTS, TITLE AND INTEREST OF SAID CITY IN A CERTAIN PIPE LINE CONNECTING SPY POND IN ARLINGTON AND LITTLE POND IN BELMONT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF SAID PIPE LINE BY SAID DIVISION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Cambridge, by its proper authorities,
2 is hereby authorized to convey, for a consideration
3 of one dollar, to the division of waterways of the state
4 department of public works all the rights, title and
5 interest of said city in a pipe line connecting Spy
6 pond in the town of Arlington and Little pond in the
7 town of Belmont, constructed under the provisions
8 of chapter one hundred and sixty-five of the acts of

9 eighteen hundred and seventy-five, as amended by
10 chapter one hundred and fifty-nine of the acts of
11 eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, and the provisions
12 of any other act in amendment of, or in addition to,
13 said chapter one hundred and sixty-five. Upon such
14 conveyance, said pipe line shall be maintained and
15 kept in repair by said division of waterways of said
16 department of public works, and for said purposes,
17 said division may enter upon any land.
