To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

Under the provisions of Article LVI of the Amendments to the Constitution, I return herewith House Bill No. 1902, entitled "An Act providing that not more than Three of the Commissioners of the Department of Public Utilities shall be Members of the Same Political Party" and recommend the following amendment:

That said House Bill No. 1092 be amended by inserting in Section 2 thereof the words "or preclude the reappointment" after the words "tenure of office" and before the words "of any Commissioner" where they appear in said section.
