

SENATE No. 221

To accompany the petition of Sumner G. Whittier for legislation to designate the express highway known as the "Massachusetts Turnpike" as the Disabled American Veterans Turnpike. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE EXPRESS HIGHWAY KNOWN AS THE "MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE" AS THE DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS TURNPIKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 354 of the acts of 1952 is hereby
2 amended by striking out, in lines 6 and 7, the words
3 "Massachusetts Turnpike" and inserting in place
4 thereof the words:— Disabled American Veterans
5 Turnpike, — so as to read as follows:— *Section 1.*
6 *Massachusetts Turnpike.* — The Massachusetts Turn-
7 pike Authority (hereinafter created) is hereby author-
8 ized and empowered, subject to the provisions of this
9 act, to construct, maintain, repair and operate at such
10 location as may be approved by the state department
11 of public works a toll express highway, to be known
12 as the Disabled American Veterans Turnpike, from a
13 point in the vicinity of the city of Boston to a point at

14 or near the boundary line between the commonwealth
15 and the state of New York or such part or parts thereof
16 as it may determine, and to issue turnpike revenue
17 bonds of the Authority, payable solely from revenues,
18 to finance such turnpike.
