### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN NORFOLK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 78 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 603 of  
3 the acts of 1952, is hereby further amended by insert-  
4 ing after the word "Norfolk", in line 22, as appearing  
5 in section 3 of chapter 768 of the acts of 1951, the  
6 words:—, district court of western Norfolk,— and  
7 by striking out, in lines 32 and 33, the words " , dis-  
8 trict court of western Norfolk."
