To accompany the petition of Clifford V. Kightlinger that he be allowed credit under the State retirement laws for certain services rendered the federal government in co-operation with Massachusetts agricultural experiment station. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT TO ALLOW CREDIT UNDER CERTAIN CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAWS TO CLIFFORD V. KIGHTLINGER FOR CERTAIN SERVICE RENDERED THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN CO-OPERATION WITH MASSACHUSETTS AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clifford V. Kightlinger, a professor at the University
2 of Massachusetts, and a member of the state retire-
3 ment system, shall be entitled to creditable service
4 in said system from July first, nineteen hundred and
5 twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
6 forty-two, inclusive, during which time he was em-
7 ployed by the federal government at the Massa-
8 setts State College in co-operation with the Massa-
9 chusetts agricultural experiment station; provided,
10 that the said Clifford V. Kightlinger shall, within
11 three months after the effective date of this act, de-
12 posit in the annuity savings fund of the state retire-

13 ment system such amount as the board of retirement
14 of such system may determine as being equal to that
15 which he would have paid into said fund had such
16 period of service been creditable service under the
17 state retirement system, with regular interest thereon.
