

SENATE No. 426

To accompany the petition of William V. Ward for legislation to provide for the payment of accrued overtime to employees of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCRUED OVERTIME TO EMPLOYEES OF DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts department of cor-
2 rection is hereby authorized and directed to pay
3 all employees of that department for overtime stand-
4 ing to their credit at the prevailing rate of pay.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of this act the de-
2 partment of correction is hereby authorized to expend
3 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
