To accompany the petition of Mary Krasnogor for legislation relative to providing ramps in public buildings for the aid of handicapped persons. Public Welfare.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROVIDING OF RAMPS IN PUBLIC AND SEMI-PUBLIC BUILDINGS FOR THE AID OF HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any public or semi-public buildings constructed,
2 reconstructed, renovated, repaired or improved with
3 state or municipal funds or moneys shall be improved
4 by the addition of adequate ramps suitable for the
5 use of wheel chairs, canes, crutches and/or other
6 artificial appliances as necessary, and the side rails on
7 such ramps shall extend at least thirty inches beyond
8 each end of such ramps.
