## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT FROM THE TREASURY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO WILLIAM A. HOLCOMB.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. To provide for payment of a judgment  
2 rendered by the district court of Hampshire on June  
3 thirteenth, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, in the  
4 case of William A. Holcomb of Northampton against  
5 John L. Enright of Ware, an employee of the depart-  
6 ment of public works, that the sum of two thousand  
7 one hundred and sixty-five dollars and forty-nine  
8 cents be appropriated and the treasurer and receiver  
9 general of the commonwealth be authorized to pay  
10 such sum under the provisions of section three B of  
11 chapter twelve of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
