To accompany the petition of William E. English and others, selectmen of Falmouth, for legislation to authorize said town to vote on a referendum directing its board of water commissioners to act as sewer commissioners. Towns.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH TO VOTE WHETHER TO HAVE ITS BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS ACT AS SEWER COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Falmouth is hereby au-
2 thorized to determine upon the official ballot used
3 for the election of town officers at the annual town
4 election in nineteen hundred and fifty-three whether
5 to have the board of water commissioners of the town
6 of Falmouth act as the board of sewer commissioners
7 of the town of Falmouth, said question to be placed
8 on the ballot in substantially the following
9 form: — “Shall the town vote to have its
10 board of water commissioners act as its
11 board of sewer commissioners?”
