

To accompany the petition of John B. Hynes, mayor of Boston, David S. McIntosh, mayor of Quincy, Charles W. Hedges and other members of the General Court, for legislation to authorize the city of Boston to sell to the city of Quincy certain land in the Squantum district of the city of Quincy. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO SELL TO THE CITY OF QUINCY CERTAIN LAND IN THE SQUANTUM DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF QUINCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provi-
2 sion of general or special law, the city of Boston, by its
3 mayor, may sell to the city of Quincy for park and
4 playground purposes any part or parts or the whole
5 of the land owned by the city of Boston and situated
6 in the Squantum district of the city of Quincy; and
7 notwithstanding any contrary provision of general or
8 special law, the city of Quincy is hereby authorized to
9 pay to the city of Boston a sum not exceeding twenty-
10 five thousand dollars for such conveyance.

1 SECTION 2. The mayor of the city of Boston, in
2 the name and on behalf of said city, is authorized to
3 execute and deliver any instrument necessary to
4 convey any land sold under authority of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
