In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONVEY TO THE TOWN OF PROVINCETOWN A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works, in the name and
2 on behalf of the commonwealth, and subject to the
3 approval of the governor and council, is hereby au-
4 thorized to convey to the town of Provincetown for
5 the sum of one dollar a parcel of land containing four
6 and twenty-seven hundredths acres, more or less,
7 bounded by Collyer street, land of the town of Prov-
8 incetown, land of Mary Lopes, other land of the town
9 of Provincetown, the Catholic cemetery and other
10 land of the town of Provincetown, for playground
11 purposes and to be dedicated and known as the Manuel
12 V. Motta Athletic Field.

13 In the event that said land shall at any time cease
14 to be used for the purposes herein set forth, it shall
15 revert to the commonwealth in fee simple.
