### AN ACT EXEMPTING THE TOWN OF GOSNOLD FROM ASSESSMENT OF CERTAIN COUNTY TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In apportioning the taxes upon the  
2 several towns in the county of Dukes county, the  
3 town of Gosnold shall not be assessed for any part of  
4 the appropriations for highways, bridges, land dam-  
5 ages and the maintenance and operation of the county  
6 airport, nor shall said town benefit from any receipts  
7 or estimated receipts of said airport. In calculating  
8 the apportionment, the assessment on said town shall  
9 be made after eliminating both estimated receipts  
10 and estimated appropriations for highways, bridges,  
11 land damages and the maintenance and operation of  
12 the airport.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January  
2 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.
