To accompany the petition of Philip G. Bowker that provision be made for the payment of a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the persons responsible for the murder of Herman Glassman of Brookline. Joint Ways and Means.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MURDER OF HERMAN GLASSMAN OF BROOKLINE.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of promoting the
2 public safety there may be paid out of the state
3 treasury the sum of five thousand dollars, in the aggre-
4 gate, to any person or persons who, in consequence of
5 such offer, shall furnish information leading to the
6 arrest and conviction of the person or persons who
7 forcibly entered the house of Harry Lampert of
8 Brookline on March thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
9 fifty-three, and shot and killed Herman Glassman.
10 The governor, with the approval of the council, shall
11 have the final decision as to the person or persons who
12 shall receive the reward and in case there is more than
13 one person shall equitably apportion said reward
14 among the persons furnishing such information.
