

SENATE No. 690

To accompany the petition of Philip G. Bowker and John F. Collins for legislation to authorize the Metropolitan District Commission to convey a certain parcel of land in the city of Boston to Jamaica Plain Post No. 76, Incorporated, American Legion. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO JAMAICA PLAIN POST NO. 76, INCORPORATED, AMERICAN LEGION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission
2 is hereby authorized to convey, subject to such reason-
3 able conditions and restrictions as it may impose, to
4 Jamaica Plain Post No. 76, Incorporated, American
5 Legion, without consideration, title to so much of a
6 certain parcel of land taken by eminent domain by
7 the said commission under authority of chapter six
8 hundred and eighty-five of the acts of nineteen hun-
9 dred and fifty and situated in the Jamaica Plain sec-
10 tion of the city of Boston at the northeasterly corner
11 of South street and the Arborway, as said commission
12 shall determine to be no longer required for the pur-
13 poses for which taken. Said parcel is part of lot 20,

14 as defined in the order of taking, dated September 6,
15 1951 and recorded with the Suffolk Registry of Deeds,
16 Book 6725, Page 232, and as appearing in plan re-
17 corded therewith.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
