AN ACT DESIGNATING A PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
KNOWN AS ROUTE 2 AS THE HON. GEORGE W. STANTON
HIGHWAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. That portion of the state highway
2 known as route 2, beginning at the junction of the
3 state highway known as route 140 in the town of
4 Westminster and extending through the city of
5 Fitchburg to the junction of the state highway known
6 as route 110 in the town of Harvard, shall be known
7 and designated as the Hon. George W. Stanton High-
8 way, and suitable markers bearing said designation
9 shall be erected along said highway by the state de-
10 partment of public works.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
