

SENATE No. 741

To accompany the petition of Pierre Drewson, mayor, and others for legislation to authorize the city of Northampton to acquire certain real estate in said city. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. the city of Northampton may acquire
2 by eminent domain, or otherwise, that certain tract
3 or parcel of land and all buildings thereon situated
4 on the northwest corner of the intersection of Hatfield
5 street and Locust street in said city of Northampton,
6 which land and buildings are presently owned by the
7 Northampton Electric Lighting Company.

1 SECTION 2. To provide the necessary funds for
2 the acquisition of said land and buildings the said
3 city of Northampton may borrow such sums as may
4 be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one
5 hundred and one thousand dollars, and may issue
6 bonds or notes therefor which shall bear on their
7 face the words, Northampton Public Works Building
8 Loan, Act of 1953. Such loan shall be payable in

9 not more than twenty years from its date. Indebted-
10 ness incurred under this act shall be outside the debt
11 limit, but shall, except as provided herein, be subject
12 to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive
13 of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of
14 section seven thereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance of the city council of the city of North-
3 ampton.
