RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO STUDY AND REVISE THE LAWS RELATING TO PUBLIC WELFARE.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission established
2 by chapter thirty-three of the resolves of nineteen
3 hundred and fifty-three, to study and revise the laws
4 relating to public welfare, in making its study, shall
5 consider the subject matter of current senate docu-
6 ment numbered 730, providing for an investigation
7 and study by a special commission relative to assist-
8 ance to persons who are permanently disabled, and
9 related matters.
