RESOLVE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONTINUE TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO IMPROVING FAIRHAVEN HARBOR.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to continue to make
3 an investigation and study relative to the advisability
4 and expediency of providing for the improvement of
5 the port facilities at Fairhaven Harbor. Said depart-
6 ment shall, in making its investigation and study,
7 consider the subject matter of current house docu-
8 ment numbered 2771, providing for an investigation
9 and study by said department relative to a sidewalk
10 along a portion of U. S. Route 6 in the town of Fair-
11 haven. Said department shall report to the general
12 court the results of its investigation and study, and
13 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of
14 legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
15 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the
16 house of representatives on or before the first Wednes-
17 day of December in the current year.
