RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO FORT POINT CHANNEL AND CERTAIN TERRITORIES ADJACENT THERETO AND TO CERTAIN PROPOSED WATERWAYS PROJECTS.

1     *Resolved*, That the department of public works is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to continue an in-  
3 vestigation and study provided for by chapter forty-  
4 three of the resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-  
5 two, relative to relocating and abandoning certain  
6 harbor lines in the vicinity of South Boston, Fort  
7 Point Channel and Atlantic Avenue and providing for  
8 the filling and improvement of South Bay, Roxbury  
9 Canal, and part of Fort Point Channel in Boston  
10 Harbor and certain territories adjacent thereto. Said  
11 department shall include in its study the subject matter  
12 of current house document numbered 1835, providing  
13 for the dredging of Palmer Cove in the city of Salem  
14 by the department of public works; of current house  
15 document numbered 1839, authorizing and directing  
16 the department of public works to dredge Belle Isle  
17 Channel in the Beachmont section of Revere; and of  
18 current house document numbered 1840, providing  
19 for the improvement of the banks of the Merrimack  
20 river in the city of Lowell. Said department shall  
21 report to the general court the results of its investi-

22 gation and study, together with drafts of legislation  
23 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,  
24 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of repre-  
25 sentatives not later than the first Wednesday in  
26 December in the current year.
