## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN JUSTICES  
AND CLERKS OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY  
OF BOSTON.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would  
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which is in part to make  
3 immediately available certain increases in compensa-  
4 tion provided for therein, therefore this act is hereby  
5 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
6 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
2 section two A of chapter seven hundred and forty-  
3 nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-one,  
4 any justice of the municipal court of the city of  
5 Boston who was appointed to said office between the  
6 first day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-  
7 one, and the thirty-first day of December, nineteen  
8 hundred and fifty-two, both dates inclusive, and any  
9 first assistant clerk of said court for civil business

10 appointed on or after September first, nineteen hun-  
11 dred and fifty-one, shall receive such salary as is  
12 provided by sections seventy-five and seventy-five A,  
13 respectively, of chapter two hundred and eighteen of  
14 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January  
2 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.
