AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR TEMPORARY LABORERS AND CHAUFFEURS AT STATE-OWNED AIRPORTS FOR SNOW REMOVAL WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out
3 the paragraph as amended by chapter 397 of the acts
4 of 1949, and inserting in place thereof the following: —
5 The labor service of the state department of public
6 works and the state airport management board
7 except: (1) Laborers and chauffeurs employed be-
8 tween November fifteenth and April fifteenth to be
9 used in connection with the removal of snow and the
10 sanding of slippery surfaces with the incidental work
11 thereto on the highways and airports of the common-
12 wealth, such employment in each case not to exceed
13 a total of ninety days within that period, and such
14 employees shall not be used to do work performed by
15 regular employees when available and able to perform
16 the work satisfactorily; (2) Such temporary employ-
17 ees as required during and following a disaster or
18 period of extreme danger when and as authorized by
19 the governor, but not to exceed ninety days. Prefer-
20 ence shall be given to veterans in making appoint-
21 ments and employing persons under the provisions of
22 clauses (1) and (2) of this paragraph.
