AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STATE HOUSING BOARD TO DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO EMPLOYEES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which is to make the pro-
3 visions contained herein effective forthwith, therefore
4 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public con-
6 venience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 64 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by inserting the
3 following two sentences after the first sentence of the
4 second paragraph thereof:—The chairman may
5 certify, and may designate employees of the housing
6 board to certify, to the existence of any fact the exist-
7 ence of which may be a condition to the validity of
8 any bond or note of any housing authority as defined
9 in section twenty-six J of chapter one hundred and
10 twenty-one of the General Laws or of the guaranty of
11 the commonwealth or any such bond or note, and may
12 certify, and may designate employees of the housing
13 board to certify, that instruments and documents are
14 true copies of instruments and documents on file
15 with the housing board. Any person dealing with
16 any such housing authority or the housing board shall
17 be entitled to rely upon such certifications as conclu-
18 sive evidence of the matters therein certified.
