AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT MAY BE EXPENDED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE RECREATIONAL, INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL ADVANTAGES OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 106 of the acts of 1939, as
2 amended by chapter 165 of the acts of 1949, is here-
3 by further amended by striking out, in line 5,
4 the words "five thousand" and inserting in place
5 thereof the words:— eight thousand five hundred,
6 — so that the first sentence will read as follows:—
7 The county commissioners of Franklin county may,
8 for the purpose of advertising the recreational, in-
9 dustrial and agricultural advantages of said county,
10 expend such sums, not exceeding, in the aggregate,
11 eighty-five hundred dollars in any one year, as may
12 be appropriated therefor; provided, that such ex-
13 penditures from money so appropriated shall not
14 at any time be more than the sum which shall
15 have been contributed by public subscription or by
16 donation deposited with the county treasurer for
17 the purpose aforesaid.
