AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN REPAIRS TO THE STATE-OWNED HOVEY DAM IN THE TOWN OF GRAFTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to do the following
3 work on the state-owned Hovey dam in the town of
4 Grafton:—make necessary repairs to the spillway
5 and face of the dam to eliminate possible extensive
6 damage; rebuild walkway over the dam; install new
7 gates and other necessary minor repairs.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
