By Mr. Waterous of Pepperell, petition of George V. Moore and others (selectmen of Littleton and Ayer) that the Department of Public Works be authorized to erect signs relative to tourist accommodations at a certain traffic circle in the town of Concord. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN SIGNS AT A CERTAIN TRAFFIC CIRCLE IN THE TOWN OF CONCORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to install and maintain at the
3 traffic circle located at the junction of Routes 2 and
4 2A in the town of Concord suitable signs to inform
5 motorists using said circle that Route 2 is a limited
6 access way, and that Route 2A is not a limited access
7 way and that there are adequate and attractive
8 tourist accommodations along said route.
