AN ACT RELATIVE TO FURTHER STAY OF JUDGMENT AND EXECUTION IN ACTIONS OF SUMMARY PROCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 43 of the acts of 1946, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 25 of the acts of 1952,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 3,
4 the word "fifty-four" and inserting in place thereof
5 the word:— fifty-five, so as to read as follows:—
6 *Section 2.* This act shall become inoperative on
7 March thirty-first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.
