By Mr. Tynan of Boston, petition of John T. Tynan for the abolition of the State Housing Board and for transferring its powers and duties to the Commissioner of Administration and Finance. State Administration.

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE STATE HOUSING BOARD AND TRANSFERRING ITS POWERS, DUTIES, OBLIGATIONS AND PERSONNEL TO THE COMMISSIONER OF ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state housing board existing under section 64
2 of chapter six of the General Laws and amendments
3 thereof and additions thereto including all the offices
4 in said board is hereby abolished. The commissioner
5 of administration and finance shall exercise and per-
6 form all of the rights, powers, duties and obligations
7 of the state housing board. All personnel of the
8 state housing board is hereby transferred to the office
9 of the commissioner of administration and finance
10 without loss of any rights or privileges upon the
11 effective date of this act. The commissioner of
12 administration and finance shall be the lawful suc-
13 cessor of the state housing board.
